6. What does God want us to do (vv. 12-14)?
7. What does Paul mean by the word “peace” in vs. 15? How is vs. 15 often misinterpreted?
8. Why is it important to let the word of Christ dwell in us richly?
9. What does it mean to do something in the name of the Lord Jesus?
10. Is the command for wives to submit to their husbands cultural or universal? How is the wife to submit to her husband? How is the husband to love his wife?
11. Do children always have to obey their parents? Why should they obey their parents?
12. What does provoking your children mean? How can parents provoke their children?
13. Do the verses pertaining to slaves and masters apply to us today? If so, how?
