4. What does 2:6 teach us about what it is involved in becoming a Christian?
5. According to 2:6-7 what should remain the same and what should change as we mature as Christians?
6. Does 2:8 forbid Christians from studying or majoring in Philosophy?
7. What is the antidote to being deceived by unbiblical worldviews, teachings or false religions (2:9-15)?
8. What do we learn about our salvation in Christ in 2:9-15?
9. Does Paul forbid Christians from judging each other in 2:16?
10. In what areas should we not allow others to judge us for being unspiritual or unchristian (2:16-23)? What reasons does Paul give?
11. What are some errant views of Christian piety that people use to judge us?
12. Why are the rules of men ineffective in our battle against sin (2:23)? Should we not use made-man rules and/or applications in our fight against sin? What is effective against sin (2:19)?
13. Does 2:16-17 teach that the 4th commandment no longer applies to Christians?
14. What does 2:23 teach us about worship?
